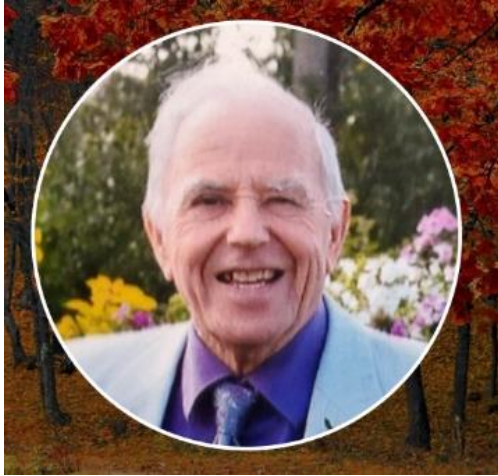


# MILLAR JOSEPH BENNETT
