Services will be in the spring for Kathleen Leora Brown, who died of breast cancer Dec. 17 at her home in Scotts Valley. She was 60.

Ms. Brown was a flight attendant and purser for American Airlines for 32 years, retiring in November 2002.

Before that, she was a restaurant manager, a model and a flight attendant on several charter airlines.

A native of California, she was raised in Richmond and lived in the Santa Cruz area for 20 years. She had lived in San Diego, Boulder Creek and Scotts Valley.
