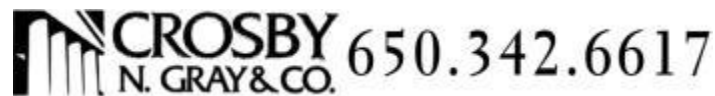


Arthur Edward Ross

Obituary

Arthur Edward Ross Passed away peacefully at home in San Mateo on Wednesday afternoon, October 24, 2007, at age 81. He was born in Kingston, Ontario, Canada on March 20, 1926 to (Lt. Col Brig. Gen.) Dr. Arthur E. Ross and Anne Ethel Stinson. He received undergraduate and medical degrees from Queen's University, Kingston, Ontario. He had a successful private medical practice in Oakville, Ontario for 20 years. In the late 1960s Art and Janet moved their family to Guadalajara, Mexico. He taught cardiology and clinical medicine at the Universidad Autonoma de Guadalajara. He and Janet also worked with and medically treated the Huichol Indians in the mountains north of Nayarit. He later worked for several years in the United States before returning to complete a post-graduate degree in public health in Toronto, Ontario. He later worked for the Canadian High Government Commission in Lagos, Nigeria. After returning to the US in the 1980s they retired in California. Arthur was predeceased by his wife, Janet Grace Kerr; and survived by his four children: David, Czashka, Cory and Alison. Arthur is also survived by his nine grandchildren: James, Cameron, Ivan, Nicholas, Peter, Shane, Jill, Robin and Leah; and his very best friend and companion, Judy Brush of San Mateo. At Arthur's request there will be no formal services. There will be a gathering of family at a later date in Canada.
