He was a night clerk in the National Hotel in Seattle Washington for 11 years. Then he came to Calif. He was a night clerk in a hotel at Santa Barbara for a few years then he went to Santa Ana, Calif was night clerk in a hotel there untill his health failed so he could not be on duty any longer he had to give up work so he passed away last May. he and I always corresponded up till he was not able to write any more. He passed away at the place where he always boarded he was 86 years old. It seems as though Aunt Rachel that is my husband's aunt raised him. I don't know which of the Uncles was his father. Probably you do.
