Pilot Officer James Ronald McClelland, son of Samuel James McClelland and Charlotte Ann Pym, was born on 6 Apr 1923 in Pembroke, died on 28 Apr 1944 in Aulnoye, France aged 21, and was buried in Maubeuge-Centre Cemetery, Maubeuge, Departement du Nord, Nord-Pas-de-Calais, France. P.O. McClelland was an Air bomber serving in 102 (R.A.F.) Sqdn., Royal Canadian Air Force, service number J88610. He was killed in a flying battle involving the Halifax II JN948. The aircraft containing the seven crew took off from Pocklington to attack Aulnoye. The aircraft did not return.
